Important Gospel Principles:

- The Holy Ghost is also called the Comforter and the Holy Spirit of Promise. If we are faithful to our covenants, we can receive the promise of eternal life through the Holy Ghost (1-5).
- The Light of Christ proceeds from God's presence, gives life and light to all creation, and is the law by which all things are governed (6-13, 41).
- The spirit body and the physical body comprise the soul of man. They will be inseparably joined in the Resurrection (14-17).
- The earth will be cleansed and sanctified and become a celestial kingdom for those who are worthy to obtain it (17-20, 25-26).
- The glory we obtain in the life to come will be determined by the laws we obey in this life. Our resurrected bodies will be quickened by that same glory (20-40).
- God has created many worlds and visits each one in its proper time. We prepare for his visit by repenting of our sins and obeying His laws (34-86).
- The Lord commands us to be cleansed from sin (74-76, 86).
- After receiving the gospel, we are to be diligent in teaching it to others (77-85).
- After the world rejects the testimony of the Lord's servants, He will send the testimony of earthquakes, thunder, lightning, and tempests (87-96).
- Those who have lived worthy of celestial glory will be resurrected first, followed by those worthy of terrestrial and then those worthy of telestial glory. The sons of perdition, or those who "remain filthy still," will be the last resurrected (29-32, 96-102).
- The Savior will reign on the earth during the Millennium. Christ and His followers will ultimately be victorious over Satan and his followers (103-116).
- The places where we receive gospel instruction should be places of prayer, fasting, faith, order, and righteousness (117-137).
