


## To Set Up:

- Cut cards out on pages 2 through 5. Page 6 can be printed out on the backs of pages 2 through 5.
- Find a timer that allows 30 seconds to one minute per turn
- Determine scoring values (i.e. 10, 8, 6, 4, and 2 points respectively). We play it in seminary with our football field and yards (25, 20, 15, 10, and 5 respectively)
- Divide into two or more equal teams.
- Determine a moderator (in family play, it can be another team and the moderator job rotates between turns).





## Object

Score points by using a series of revealing clues to guess the identity of a well-known church history person, place, thing, or date. It is up to you to determine the criteria for a team to win. For example, the first team to earn 100 points wins the game.

In our seminary class, we use yards instead of points. Each time a team scores, they earn a point. We play until we run out of time, and a that time, the team with the most points wins.

## Playing and the Rules of the Game

- The cards are shuffled and placed in a stack between the two or more teams (zones in our class).
- 2. The moderator (teacher or opposing team) takes a card from the stack and looks it over. The moderator then tells the guessing team what the subject is (located at the top of the drawn card).
- 3. The timer is then started. The guessing team has 30 seconds (or one minute—you decide) to guess the answer. Only one guess per clue is allowed.
- 4. The moderator gives the guessing team the first clue. The guessing team determines the answer and guesses it. If they do not know the answer based on the first clue, they yell "PASS" and the moderator reads the next clue.
- 5. This mode of play continues until one of the following is determined:
  - The correct answer is given
  - The time runs out
  - The guessing team has no clue what the answer is
- 6. If the answer is not determined by the end of the given time, free play is started and the opposing team can get 1 point (or 5 yards) if they can guess the answer. If more than one team is playing, the first team to raise their hand with an answer gets to guess. If they miss the answer, they lose 1 point (or 5 yards).
- 7. Once step 6 is finished, the next team becomes the guessing team and play starts over from step 2 above.
- 8. Play continues until a team reaches the determined goal or time runs out (as in Seminary it always does)!
